### **America 250: California's Place in America's Story**

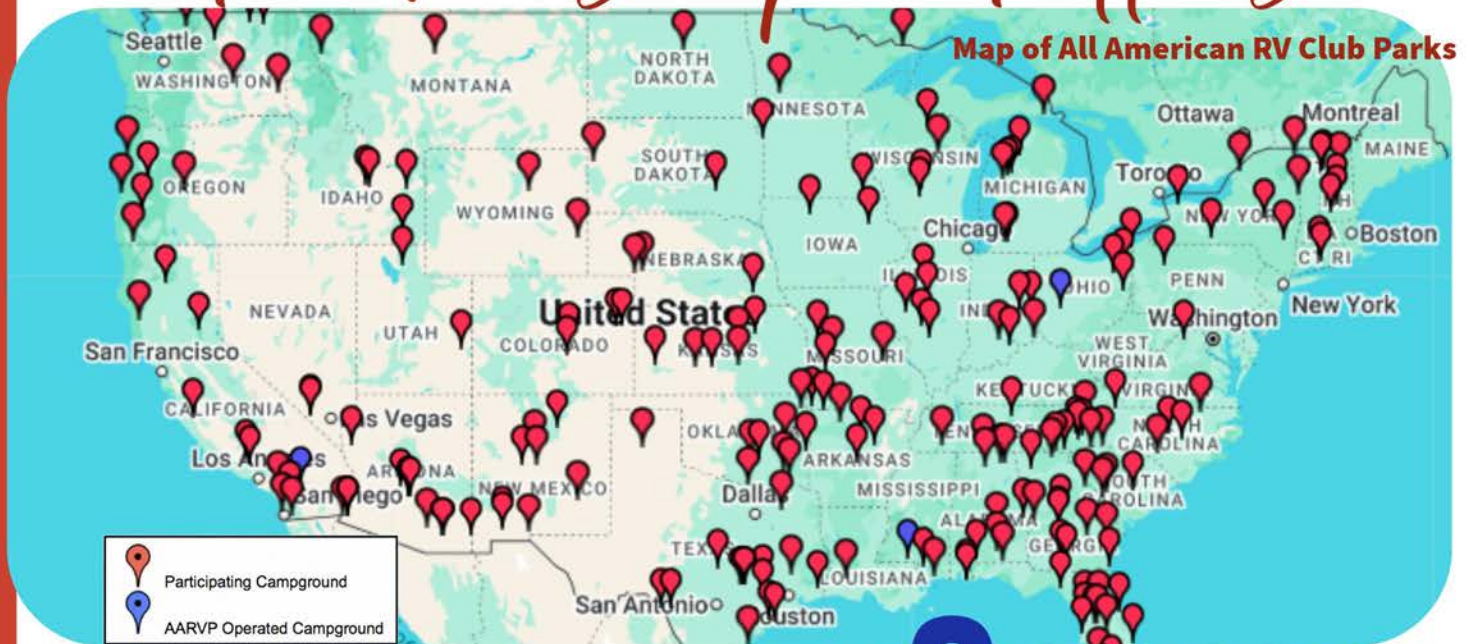
