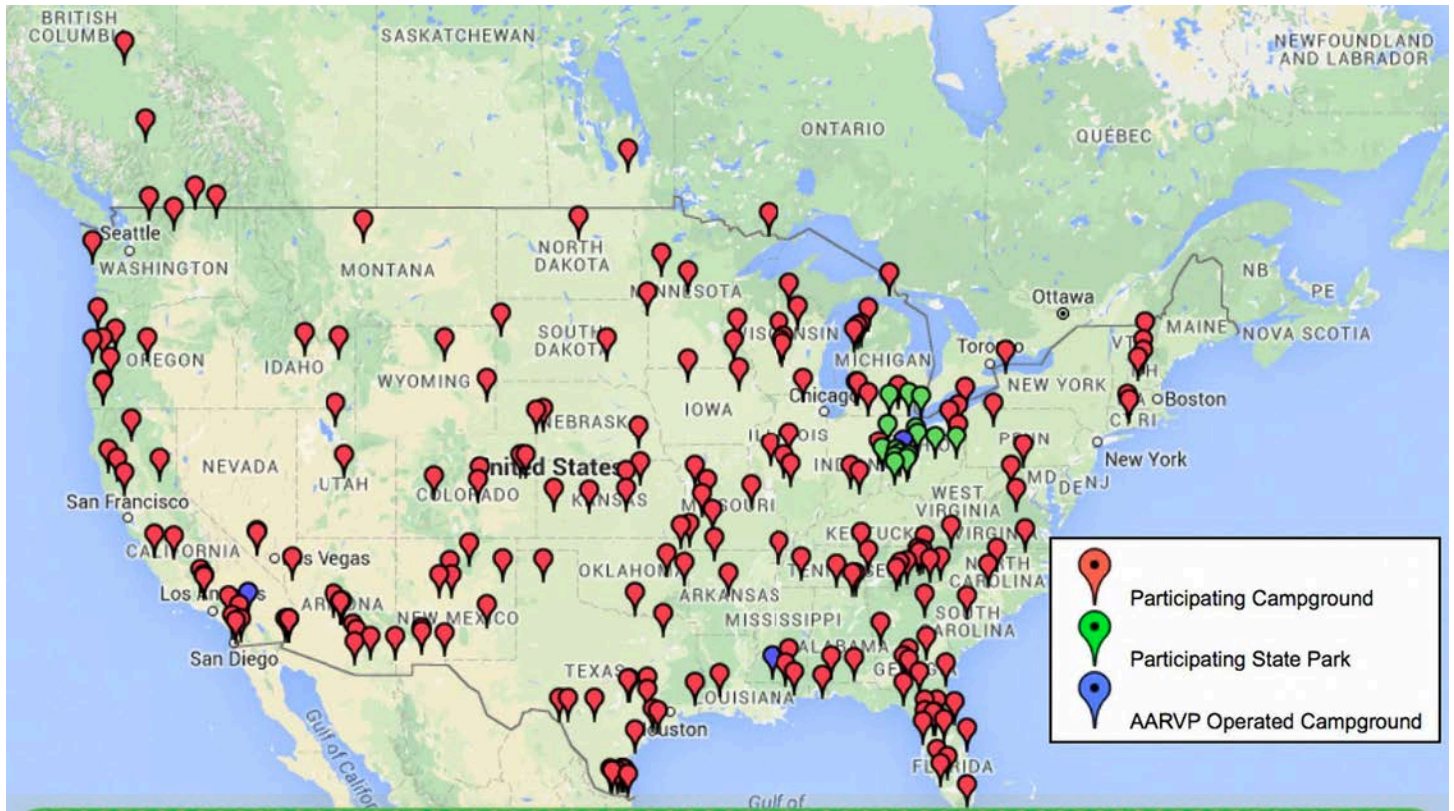

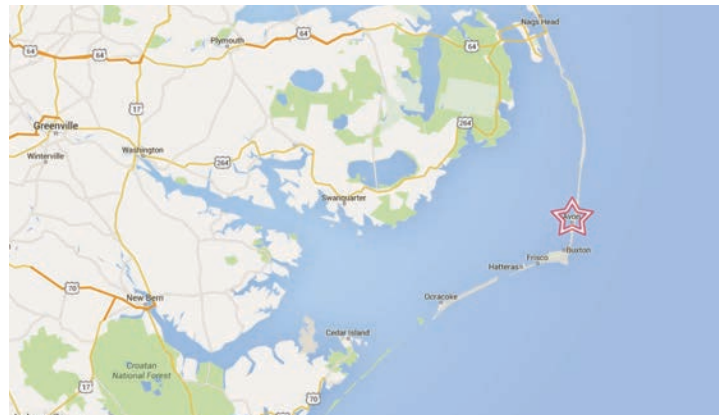
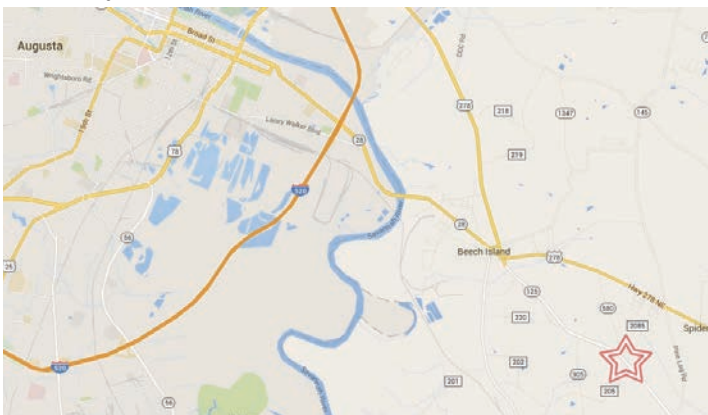

We now have quotes on the cost of electrical improvements and we're working with the corporate office to determine how much we'll be able to

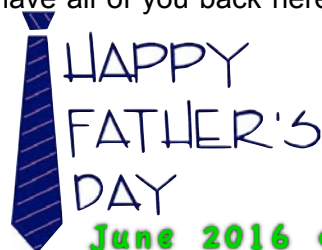
