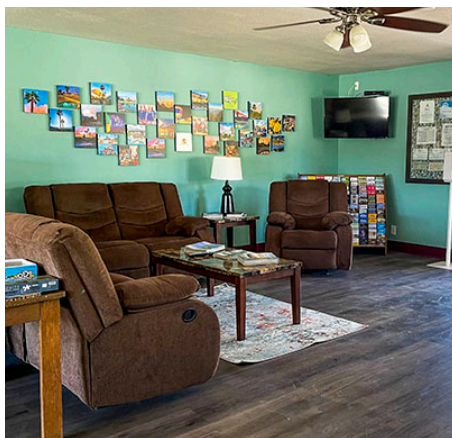

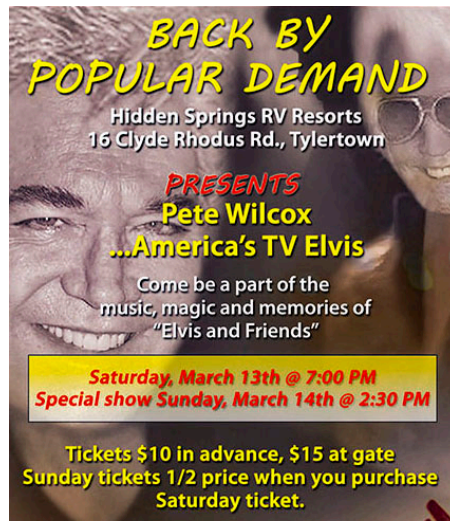

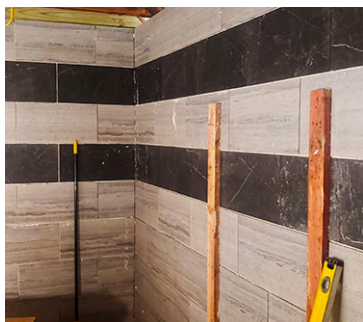

### Bath house remodel

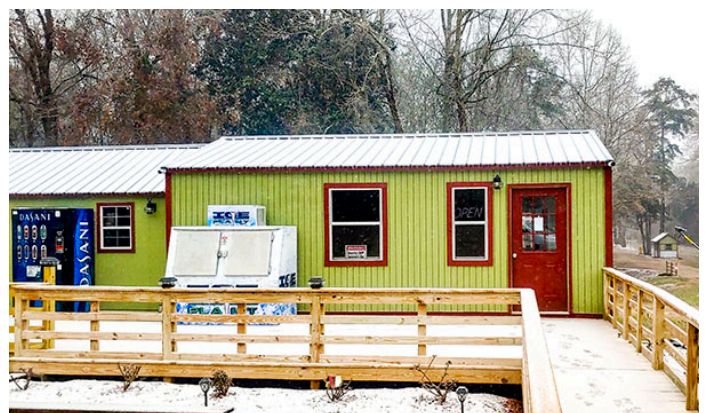
Work continues on the main bath house. The ladies' side is almost finished and we are very proud of the new look.

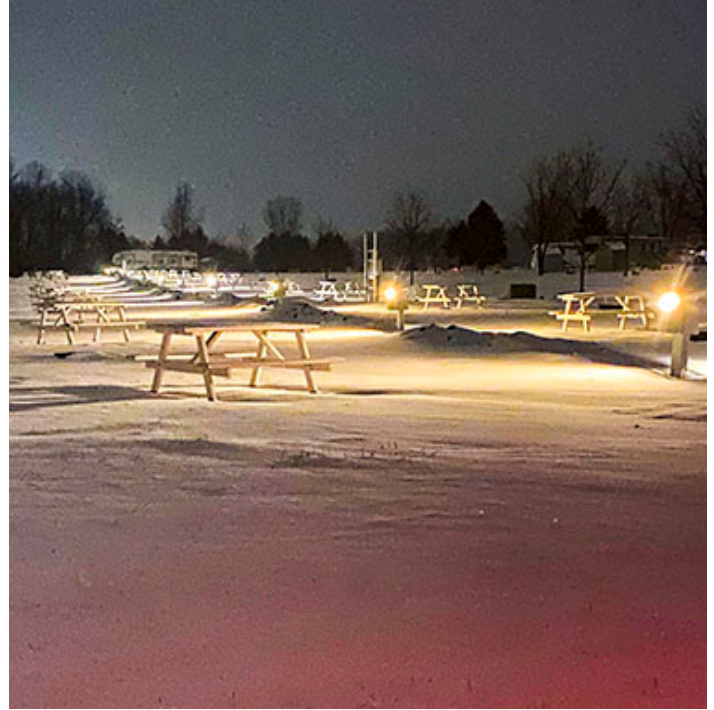




### All new men's bathroom
