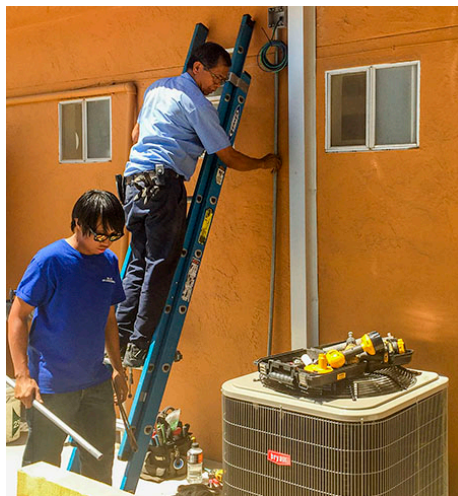

saw the park full with only a very few no shows. Everyone had a really good time with good weather and fun entertainment. We had breakfast for our guests two mornings and served quite a bit of





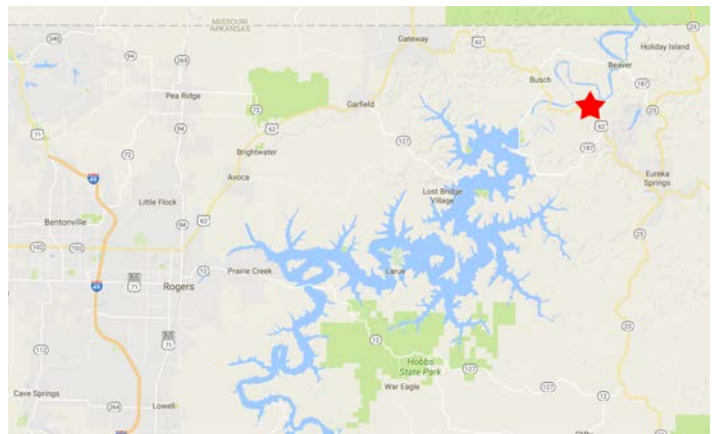

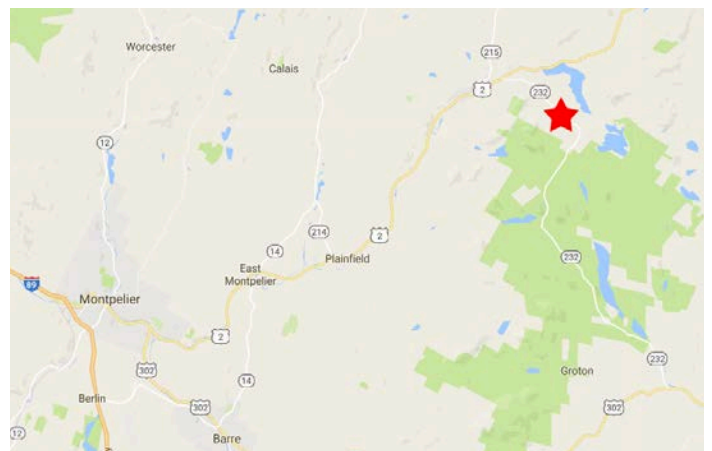
Beaver Dam Cottages & RV Park, Eureka, AR

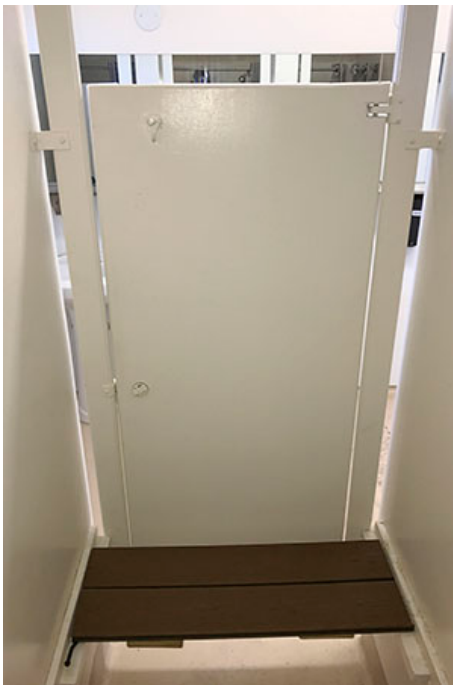

New seats in the shower area

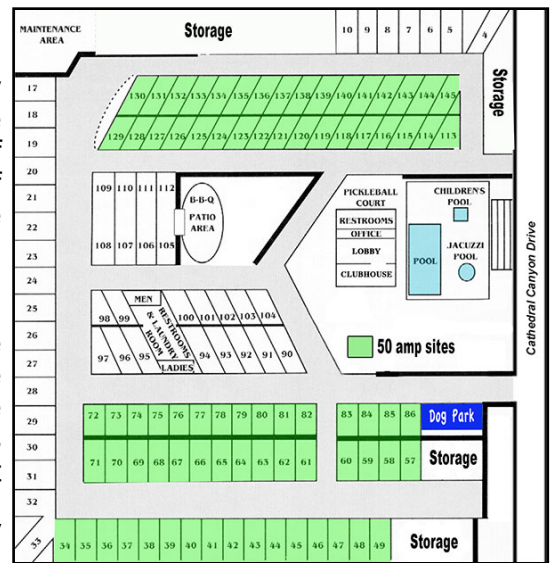
