A record number of kids and adults participated in our Arts and

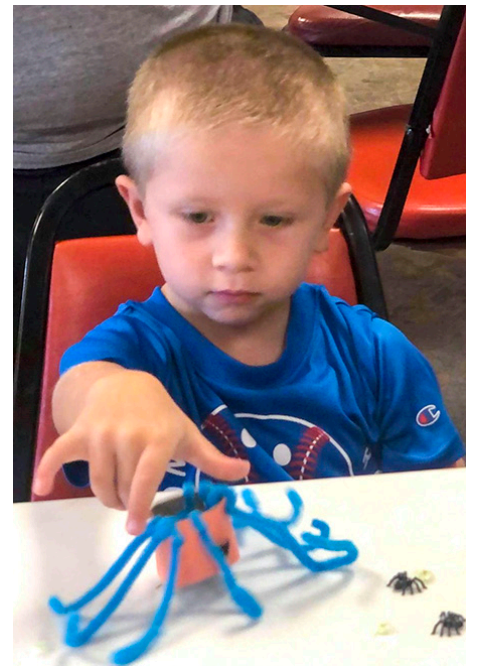

Member Benefits Corner

Did you know that as Members, you may make your reservations up to one year in advance? Public Guests may make reservations up to 6 months in advance and RPI members 60 days in advance. We want to make sure all of our Members get their reservations in for those busy holiday weekends, so plan ahead.



Members are allowed to have 6 people on their site; this includes the Member and their immediate family. Immediate family is defined as their children under the age of 26 and still living at the Member's residence. If you have more than 4 and they are not yourself or immediate family, you will be charged a per person per night fee up to 6.

Did you know that we offer Child of Member Discounts and Guest of Member Discounts? Your children can use your home park without you being there, they just need a copy of your membership card. Each child can use it 4 times per year for 7 days each visit for \$15-\$18 per night (prices subject to change). Discounts cannot be used on holiday weekends and reservations can be made 6 months in advance. Do you have a friend or neighbor that you would like to invite to come camping with you? Guest of Member discounts can only be used while you are on the park.

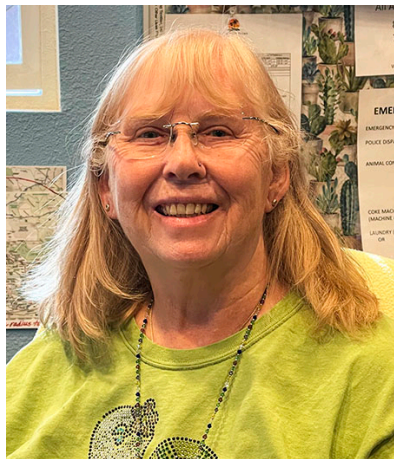
