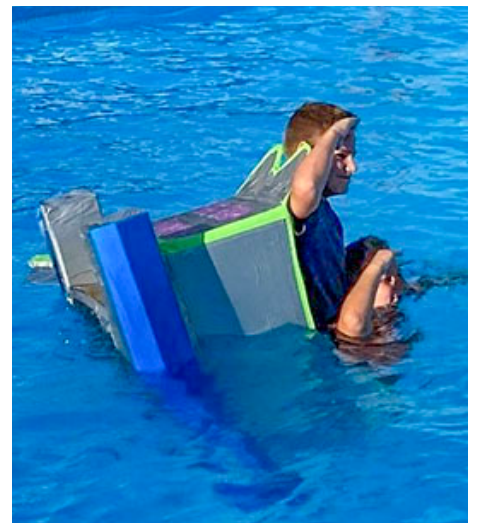

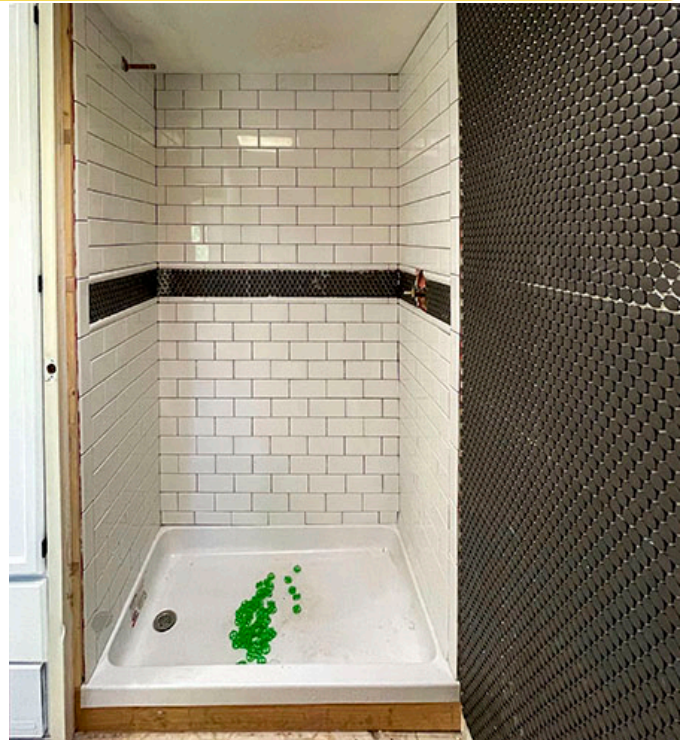

Meanwhile, we're finishing up some construction projects on the park. Uncle Bob's roadside landscaping work should be completed before most of you arrive. Those 60 pots in the picture on the first page will be set in the ground and planted with drought resistant vegetation.

Electrical service is being updated on the north side of the park, which will allow us to reopen several RV non-sewer sites currently used for storage. We're hopeful that we might be able to add sewer service in the future to make them full-service sites.

Completion is also expected soon on our rental trailer. The coach has been gutted and completely reimagined. It will feature residential appliances, all new furniture, an all new, tiled shower and many other added amenities. It will be available to members and guests and also through Airbnb.

As you celebrate the upcoming Labor Day holiday, please be safe, not only on the road but in all areas where crowds gather.

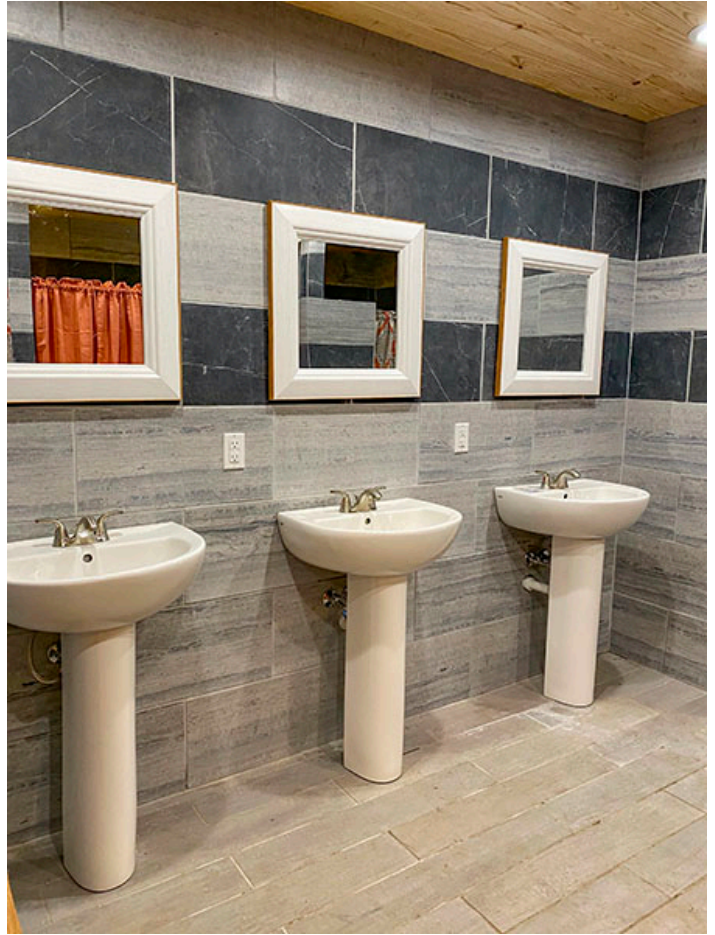

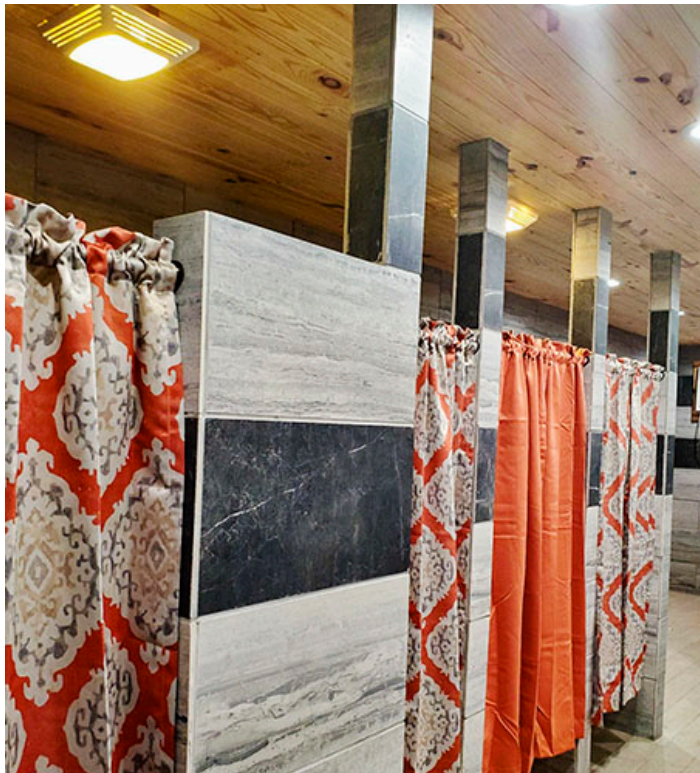
New rental trailer shower in progress
