### WELCOME BACK SNOWBIRDS!

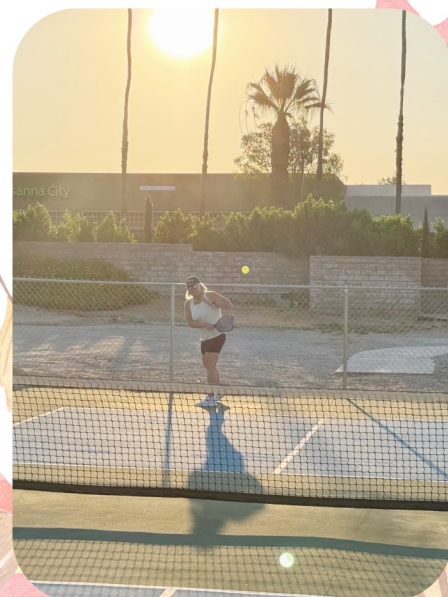

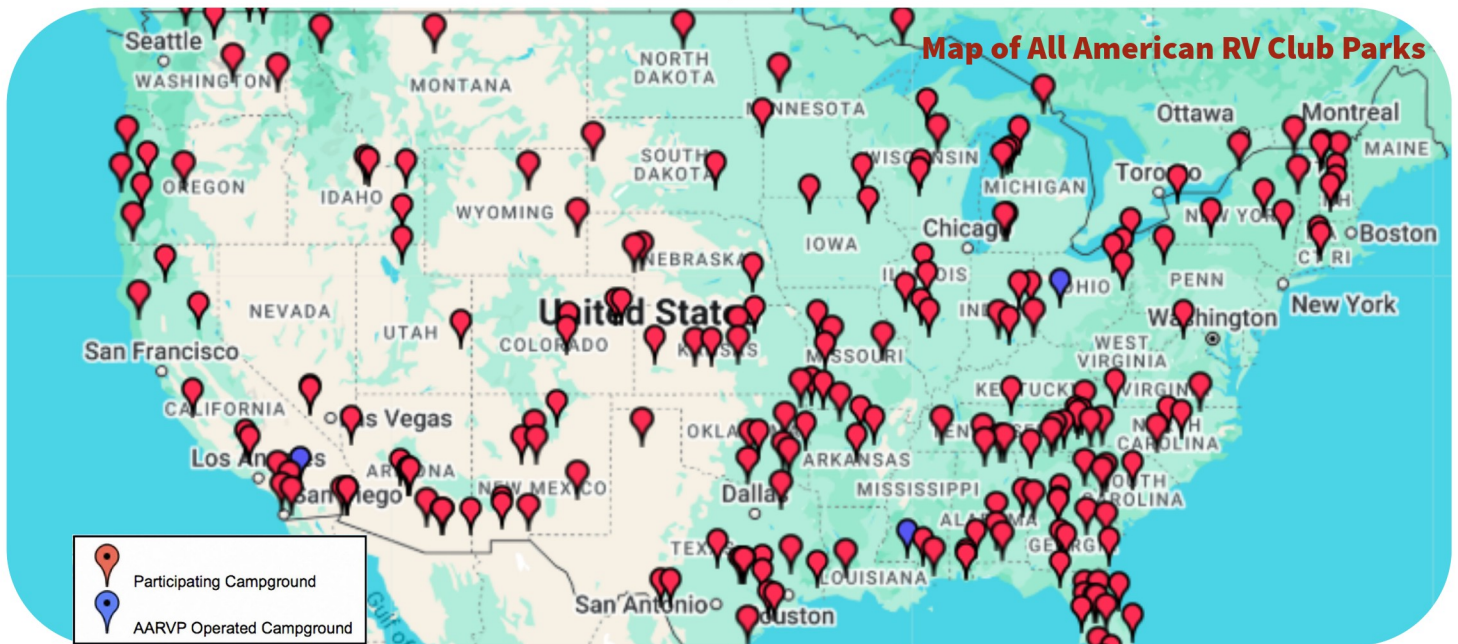

All American RV Parks will soon begin transitioning to paperless billing for membership dues and contract payments—and it could start before January 1, 2026.

To avoid delays and additional fees, **please verify the email address** listed on your most recent statement immediately. If your email is missing or incorrect, contact our office right away to **update** it.

If we do not have an email address on file by 1/1/26, we will continue to send paper statements with a **\$3.00 service fee per billing**.

Why the change? Since 2015, USPS has raised postage rates 14 times, and mailing paper bills has become too costly.
